(The National Land Finance Co operative Society was started with an objective to provide an opportunity for land ownership among estate workers. Plantation workers were persuaded to buy shares in the co-operative at RM 100/= per share, payable in monthly installment of RM10. With this, the society managed to purchase its first rubber estate covering a total of 2900 acres and today has its own rubber, oil palm and coconut plantations all over the country. To-date, the society has 49682 members who range from estate workers, students to professionals with a share capital of RM 109 million in shares. It has paid up dividends regularly to its members and allowed them to withdraw their bonus share capital, amounting to RM 50 million, to buy houses, support their children education and set up enterprises)
