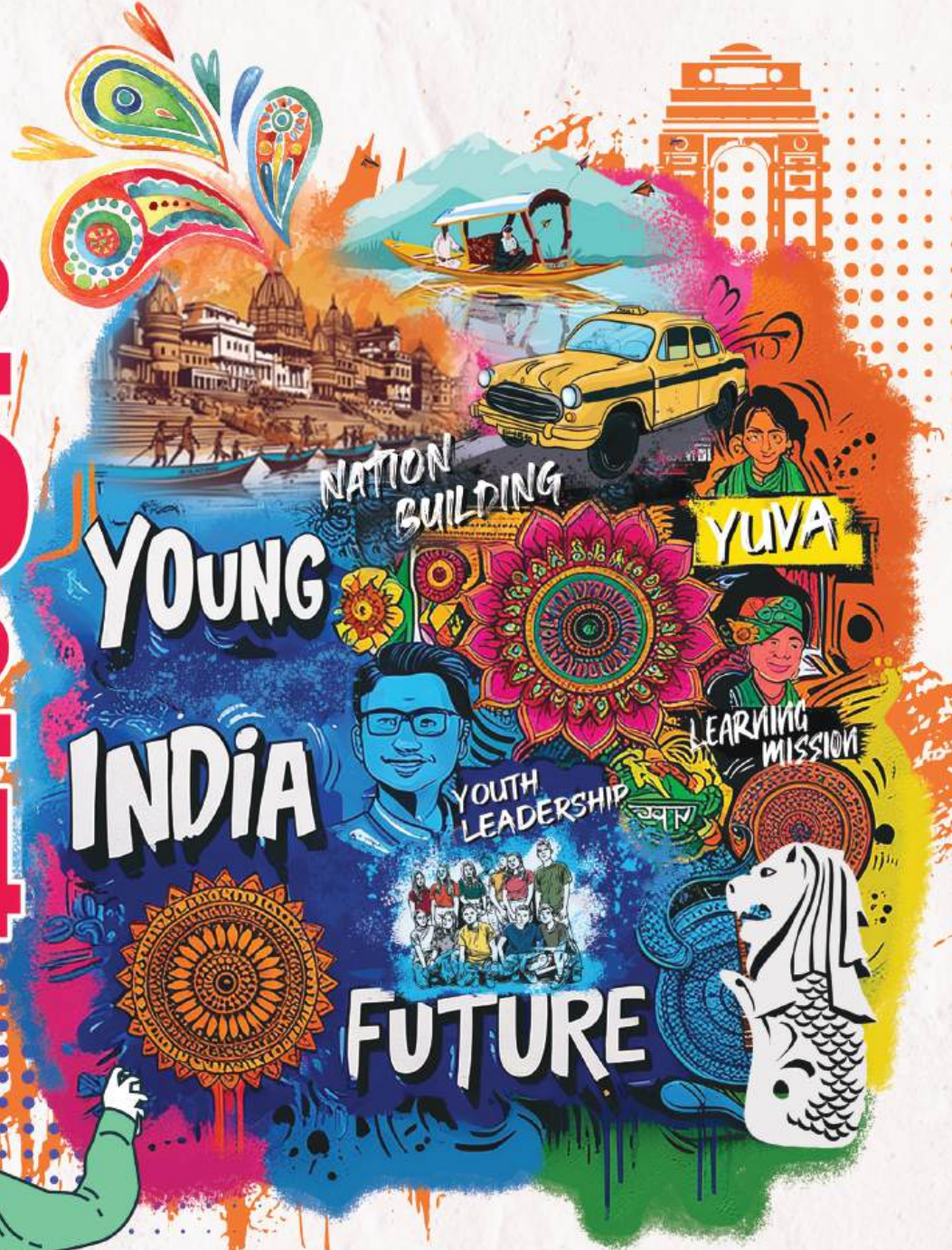

Yi Masoom Summit 2024: Creating Safe Spaces

With this year's theme, "Creating Safe Spaces: Strategies for Prevention of Child Abuse", the summit emphasized proactive measures such as early intervention, empowering children, and strengthening community support systems.

The event featured impactful discussions and expert-led sessions, addressing critical aspects of child protection:

- Panel Discussion on "Tackling Adolescent Abuse Together": Experts highlighted the vulnerabilities faced by adolescents and the need for a multi-stakeholder approach to address the issue.

Each teachers has been asked to sensitize atleast 100 students, which can impact 3 lakh students

Yi Road Safety National tie-up with VRL Transport



YI Hubballi Chapter in association with EMRI – GHS will train more than 12000 VRL drivers and staff in Hubballi and other cities throughout India. The project Farishtey - Certified Accident First Responders project will train the drivers with the essential life-saving skills like CPR and first aid for critical injuries such as bleeding, fractures, and amputations. This will help the accident victims within the golden hour. This is a huge step towards road safety and responsible citizenship. They are the real impact makers on the road. Yi health

Our flagship programs, like ‘Break the Stigma’, and ‘Strong Mind Strong World’, encourage adults and young people to focus on mental resilience. These mental health initiatives involve workshops & sessions to build awareness about breaking the stigma around mental health, and teach individuals to build emotional strength, support each other in times of need, and seek help. Our mental health program promotes ‘Tele MANAS’ (a

Government of India initiative run by NIMHANS), which is a 24/7 toll free helpline that has made mental health care more accessible to people in India, especially in rural areas.

‘Yi Run for Mental Health’ is a series of runs across Yi chapters, to spread mental health awareness. This program harnesses the power of running events to create awareness and advocacy for mental wellness. Yi Runs were organized across Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Dehradun, Jamshedpur, Hubballi, Nasik, Rajkot, Sivakasi, Salem, Karur, Trivandrum, and Vizag, with more than 15,000 runners participating to support the cause.

Peer pressure can be powerful, especially when it comes to things like trying drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. ‘Say No to Peer Pressure’ is an awareness program specially designed for YUVA students, to enable them to protect their future from substance abuse, and be confident in their ability to say NO.



'A Dialogue with YUVA' was organized across 21 cities, engaging college students to advocate the prevention of substance abuse. This initiative had active participation from the local Narcotics Bureau, Police Department, Educators, and Health stakeholders.

From promoting mental well-being to preventing substance abuse, Yi Health also engages both urban and rural children from Thalir & Rural Initiatives. In a country where waterborne diseases still pose a significant threat to children, Yi Health has launched the 'Hygiene Heroes' program. Focused on promoting hand washing and personal hygiene among schoolchildren, this initiative also focuses on enabling the availability of clean and safe water for children in schools. 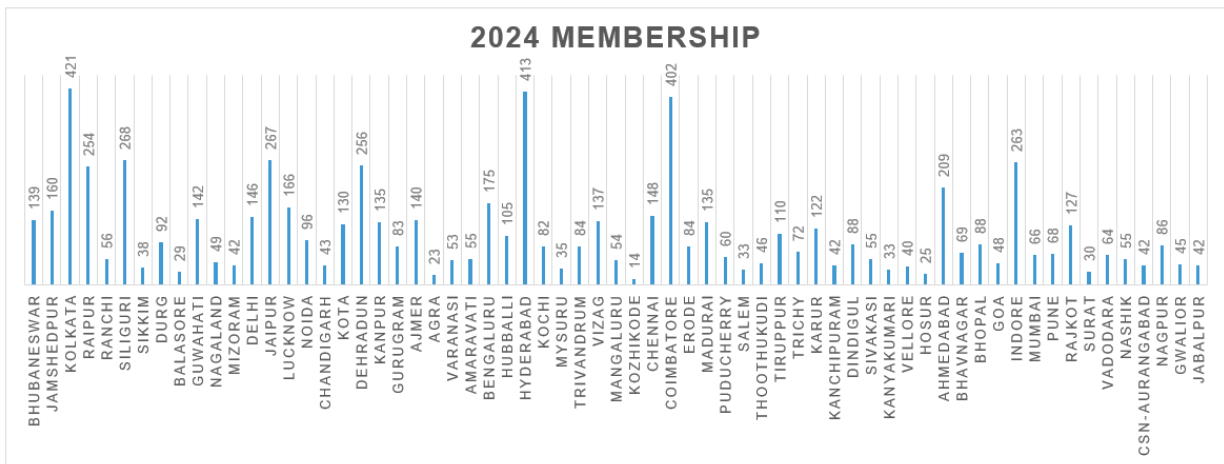

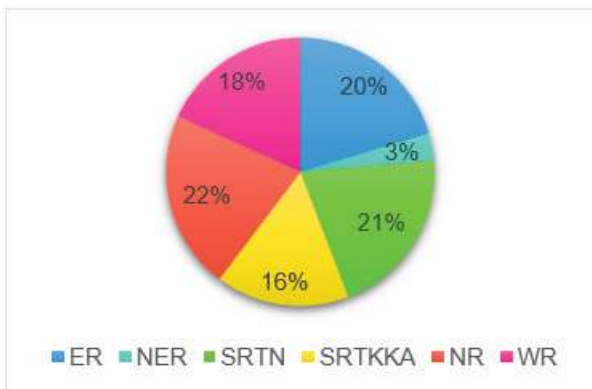

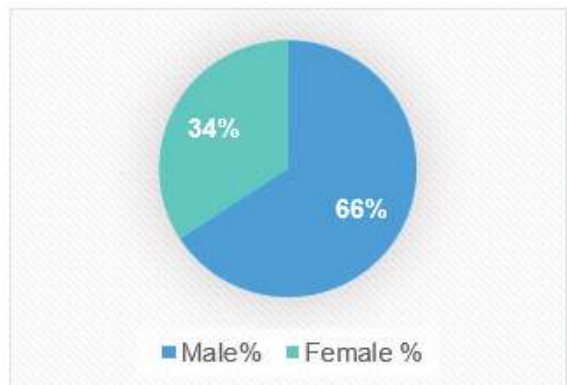

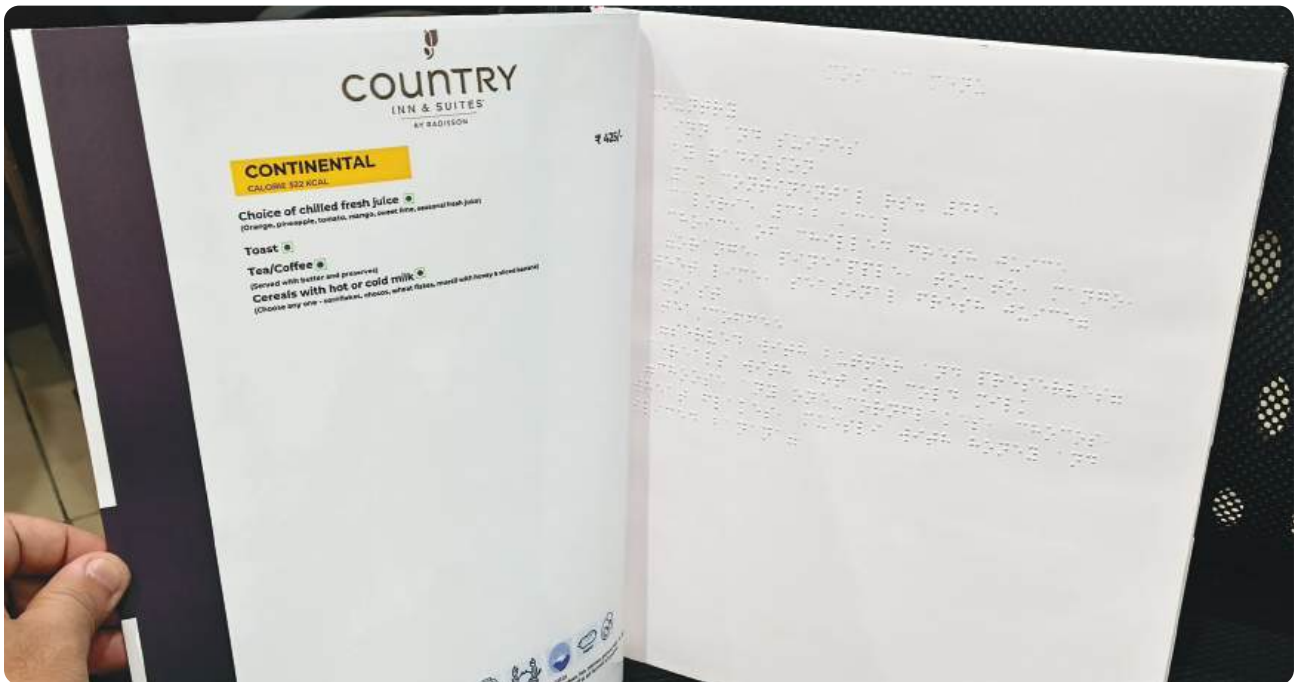
The Delhi Youth Conclave (DYC)

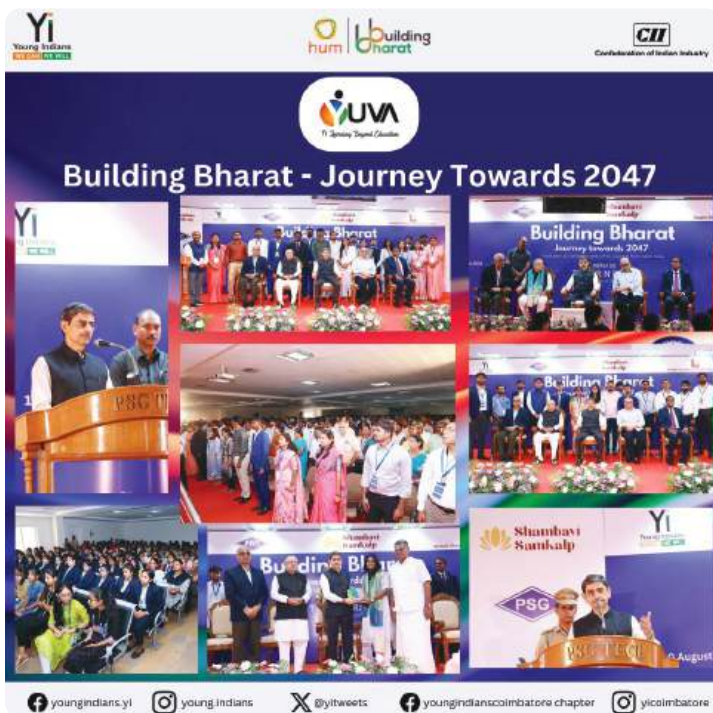


Building Bharat - Journey Towards 2047

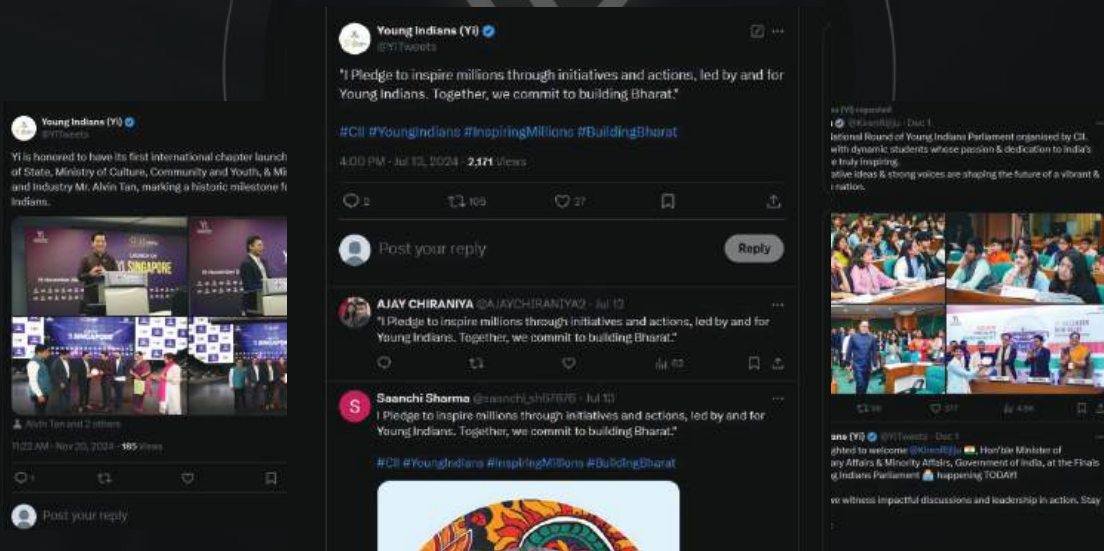

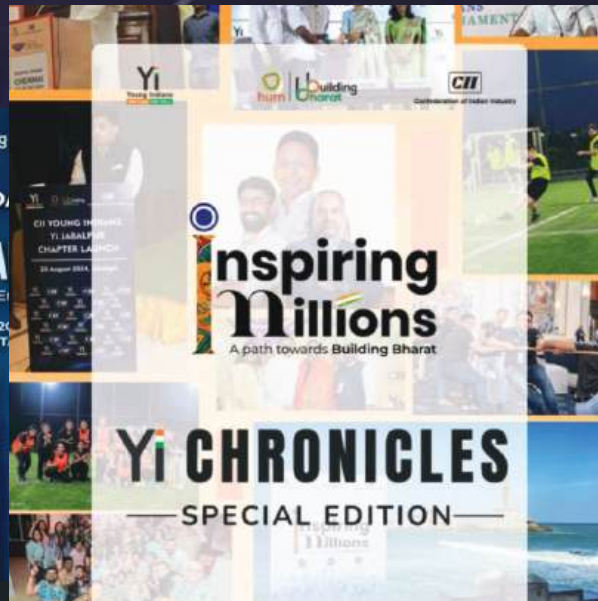
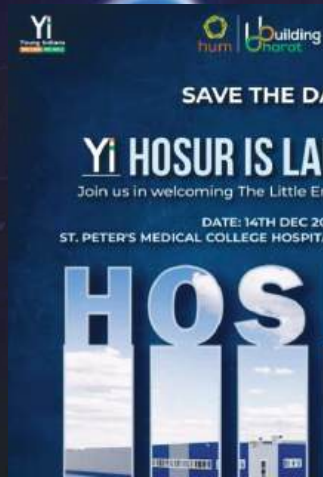

KOLKATA: To promote inclusivity and accessibility to everyone can experience the rich history through the country's freedom struggle, the Alipore Jail Museum on Wednesday saw the introduction of facilities for persons with disabilities.

The formal inauguration was made by Kolkata Mayor Firdah Hakim who is also the chairman of West Bengal Housing & Infrastructure Development Corporation (WBHIDCO). "We want inclusivity in society. Hence, we heartily welcome the Braille facilities. The visually impaired persons will also be able to gain knowledge about the rich collection associated with Bengal's freedom struggle that this museum boasts of with the help of the Braille system," Hakim said.

The museum, developed by HIDCO, was inaugurated on September 21, 2022 by Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee to portray a history of Indian freedom struggle with emphasis on the Bengal chapter.

YI Kolkata, an integral part of CII (Confederation of Indian Industry) developed the facilities in the museum. "This project is a testament to YI Kolkata's commitment to creating inclusive spaces for all. By making the Alipore Jail Museum accessible to the visually impaired and persons with disabilities, we are not just opening doors, but breaking barriers. It's an honour to have been a part of this meaningful initiative," said Balraj Agarwal, YI Kolkata Chair 2024.

The facilities include 44 indicators, 53 general signs, 4 ramps and 1 wheelchair. In 2022, the YI Accessibility Kolkata Team visited the Calcutta Blind School and received insightful feedback from the principal who suggested that the Alipore Jail Museum should be made accessible for the visually-impaired and persons with disabilities. Following this, the team organised a trip to the museum and proposed the same to its director Dr Jayanta Sengupta. The latter sought approval from the HIDCO authorities and secured the necessary approvals for the project.

"The inclusive facilities in the museum have created a template where corporates can come forward to help public institutions. We hope that more corporates will follow suit for making museums inclusive and accessible," said Sengupta.

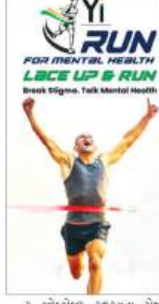
