



INCLUSIVITY WITH BRAILLE - ENABLED CONSTITUTION



## "When knowledge becomes accessible, true freedom begins."

Bengaluru has turned this belief into reality by unveiling the Braille-enabled Indian Constitution, marking a historic stride toward a more inclusive India.

The initiative introduces India's foundational legal document in Braille, empowering the visually impaired to access, read, and understand the very framework that defines their rights and responsibilities as citizens.

This transformative project is the result of a collaborative effort between CII Young Indians (Yi) Bengaluru and Sankara Eye Hospital, Bengaluru. It was officially launched by Shri Thawar Chand Gehlot, Governor of Karnataka, underscoring strong institutional support.

RAIPUR TAKES THE LEAD WITH ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS CAR RALLY



### "Safety on the road is a choice we make every day"

On 26th January, Raipur came alive with a powerful message as a Road Safety Awareness Car Rally rolled out to promote safe driving practices and raise awareness about road safety.

# WHAT

The rally featured an impressive lineup of 35 - 40 super sports cars and 30+ memberowned vehicles, with more than 40 Yi Raipur members participating actively. The event showcased the energy and commitment of the community towards safer roads

The event was honored by the presence of key dignitaries from the Traffic Police Department, including DSP and ASP officers, along with Yi National Chair Tarang Khurana and National Chair for Road Safety Namrata Bhatt. Their insights emphasized the urgent need for road safety education and responsible driving.

# IMPACT

A major announcement from Union Minister Nitin Gadkari introduced roadside assistance benefits for accident victims, marking a significant advancement in road safety measures. The launch of new road safety signboards, which will be installed in Thalir schools, aims to educate young students on traffic rules and safe road behavior from an early age. 
