





ACCIDENT FIRST RESPONSE IN ACTION

YI FARISHTEY RAVNEET OBEROI SAVES LIVES IN **NOIDA SECTOR 5**



"Real Heroes Don't Wear Capes—They Wear Confidence & Carry a First Aid Kit"

When an accident struck Noida's Sector 5 on the night of 17th March 2025, chaos, confusion, and helplessness filled the air. Multiple people were injured, stranded in auto-rickshaws with no medical help in sight. A crowd gathered—but no one knew what to do. That's when Yi Farishtey Ravneet Oberoi, a Yi Noida Member and Certified Accident First Responder, stepped up. Armed with skills and calmness, Ravneet and his trained team did what truly mattered—they took action.

- Emergency first aid was provided by Ravneet and his team to several severely injured accident victims.
- Ambulance was called and victims were stabilized during the critical golden hour.
- Prevented improper handling of patients by untrained bystanders.

- Yi Farishtey Accident First Responder Training empowered Ravneet to act swiftly and responsibly.
- Team of Yi Certified members coordinated efforts with ambulance services.
- Ensured calm, control, and effective medical support at the scene.

IMPACT

- Multiple lives saved during the golden hour.
- Awareness raised on the urgent need for First Aid training across India.
- Highlighted the critical gap in accident response preparedness among citizens.
