Dear Member,

In the 1st quarter of 2025, the number of Thalir schools has grown 12% from the beginning of the year. Guwahati and Lucknow have onboarded large number of public schools opening the path for Yi to include government school children to the foray. Over 1200 programs were conducted across the country educating approximately 7 lakh students on Road Safety, Child Safety, Health and AI technologies.

Young Indians Parliament (YIP) 2.0 was officially launched with the goal to conduct the sessions at every chapter of Yi. About 40 of the 72 chapters have shown keen interest in conducting chapter YIP rounds. A national orientation call was conducted for Yi members to build the capacity of YIP moderators. Young Indians' Climate Change vertical is on a mission—restoring balance, nurturing nature, and igniting responsible environmental action. From tree plantations to water rejuvenation, from e-waste drives to Miyawaki forests—impact echoes across chapters.

WHAT

- 🌱 **25,800+ trees planted** across India
