

1st BIMSTEC YOUTH SUMMIT 2025

Yi as Knowledge Partner to the Government of India

7 - 11 FEB 2025 | GANDHINAGAR, GUJARAT

India hosted the first-ever **BIMSTEC Youth Summit** on the theme "Youth as a Bridge for Intra-BIMSTEC Exchange." Organised by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and the Ministry of External Affairs, the summit brought together youth leaders, policymakers, and innovators from across BIMSTEC nations.

As the **Knowledge Partner**, Yi shaped dialogues on youth empowerment, digital transformation, cybersecurity, and cross-cultural collaboration.

High-level sessions featured the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat and the Union Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports, with Yi leadership moderating the **Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue** for BIMSTEC delegates. Breakout sessions explored AI, digital infrastructure, and startup cybersecurity, complemented by cultural visits to Dandi Kutir, Sabarmati Ashram, Riverfront, and a tour of **GIFT City** showcasing India's smart financial ecosystem.

The summit served as a landmark platform for **policy exchange, technology insights, and future cooperation** across BIMSTEC countries.







VIKSIT BHARAT YOUNG LEADERS DIALOGUE (VBYLD)

11 Roundtables Across India · Yi as Knowledge Partner

Yi continued its national collaboration with the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports through the **VBYLD Round Tables**, designed to build youth-led policy recommendations for **Viksit Bharat @2047**.

In 2025, Yi conducted **11 roundtables** across Gandhinagar, Bhopal, Bengaluru, Dehradun, Siliguri, Bhavnagar, Chandigarh, Pune, Chennai, Gurugram, and Puducherry.

Each session enabled collaborative problem-solving, sectoral insights, and actionable strategies—ensuring that young leaders contribute meaningfully to India's long-term development vision.









EMPOWERMENT THROUGH INDEPENDENT MOBILITY

Maersk × Young Indians × CII Foundation × NeoMotion Indore & Nagpur

Yi's flagship inclusion program, **Empowerment Through Independent Mobility**, transformed the lives of persons with locomotor disabilities by combining mobility technology with dignified livelihood opportunities.

Through CSR support and strategic partnerships, **57 beneficiaries** received **NeoFly** and **NeoBolt** assistive devices, clinical assessments, structured training, and onboarding into delivery roles with **Zomato**.

The initiative removed mobility barriers, lowered transportation costs, and created pathways for **financial independence and social inclusion**, with projected earnings of ₹55+ lakhs in 12 months.

Beyond economic uplift, the program strengthened confidence, community participation, and long-term livelihood security—demonstrating a scalable model for nationwide disability inclusion.











Yi Regional Members Demographics







The **Cervavac vaccine** administered provides protection against high-risk HPV strains, significantly reducing the risk of cervical and related cancers. 


