BRICS Youth Entrepreneurship Working Group Meeting Strengthens Global Collaboration

The BRICS Youth Entrepreneurship Working Group Meeting, held on 20–21 May 2026 in Indore under India’s BRICS Chairship 2026 and organized by the Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, brought together young entrepreneurs, industry leaders, and delegates from BRICS nations.

The platform fostered dialogue on innovation, sustainability, and future-ready entrepreneurial ecosystems.

Young Indians actively contributed through the presence of National Chairman Mr. Arun Rathod and the participation of members from the Yi Indore Chapter as speakers, exhibitors, and entrepreneurial representatives.



VERTICAL UPDATES

Yi Pune Hosts Job & Internship Fair 2026

Yi Pune in collaboration with MIT World Peace University and its 32 colleges, successfully organized the Job & Internship Fair 2026, connecting students and young professionals with career opportunities across sectors.

The fair witnessed participation from 15+ companies offering 50+ positions, with 25+ job offers already extended while interviews continue for additional roles. Over 120 students from Engineering, Business Studies, and undergraduate streams participated, making the initiative a strong platform for youth employability and industry engagement.



Yi Kanpur Organizes Mega Internship & Placement Drive at HBTU

Yi Kanpur successfully conducted a Mega Internship & Placement Drive at HBTU under the recently signed MoU between Yi Kanpur and HBTU.



The initiative saw participation from 14 companies across sectors including AI, Pharma, Software, Healthcare, Food, Construction, and Manufacturing. Around 200 students from MBA, BBA, and B.Tech streams participated, resulting in 35 students securing opportunities while 50 advanced to second-round interviews. The event further strengthened industry-academia collaboration and youth empowerment in the region.

Yi National Trek Conquers Buran Ghati

The Young Indians National Trek to Buran Ghati concluded successfully, with all 31 participants reaching the summit and completing a journey defined by determination, resilience, and teamwork.

The trek provided members with an opportunity to challenge their limits, build lasting connections, and experience the spirit of adventure amidst the Himalayas.

The successful expedition stands as a testament to the collective perseverance of the trekkers and the dedicated efforts of the organizers and trek leaders who ensured a safe and memorable experience.



Yi Kanpur Launches Citywide CPR Training Initiative

Yi Kanpur's Road Safety Team has launched a special citywide initiative to conduct CPR training sessions across members' offices and industries, with an ambitious goal of training 20,000 employees this year.

Marking the beginning of the initiative, the first training session was successfully conducted for over 100 workers at Agrow Healthcare Private Limited. Guided by Dr. Sunit Gupta, participants received hands-on emergency response and life-saving CPR training, reinforcing workplace safety and preparedness.



Yi Hyderabad Conducts EMRI Emergency Response Training Sessions

Young Indians Hyderabad organized four EMRI Emergency Response Training sessions on 23 May in collaboration with the Terapanth Task Force (NDRF-trained trainers).



The programs were conducted at South Clan Football Academy, Jubilee Hills; East Coast Magnets Pvt. Ltd., Jeedimetla; Maruti Udyog, Kukatpally; and Manikan Cables Pvt. Ltd., Jeedimetla, engaging over 175 participants. Focused primarily on industrial labourers, the sessions provided practical training on burns, bleeding, choking, CPR, emergency carrying, and lifting techniques, strengthening workplace emergency preparedness and safety awareness.

Yi Kanchipuram Conducts EMRI First Responders Program for School Bus Drivers

On 16 May 2026, Yi Kanchipuram organized the EMRI Accident First Responders Program for over 390 school bus drivers during the School Bus Fitness Inspection Program, held in the presence of the District RTO and District Sub-Collector. EMRI trainers conducted practical sessions on emergency response, accident handling, and essential first aid techniques, equipping drivers with critical skills to ensure student safety during emergencies.

Yi Bhubaneswar Promotes Road Safety Through Awareness Drive

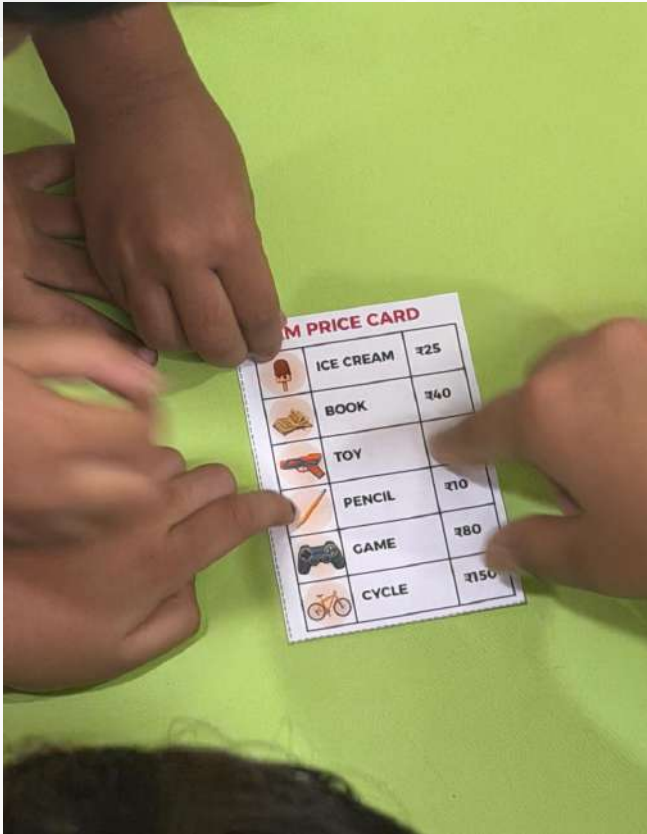

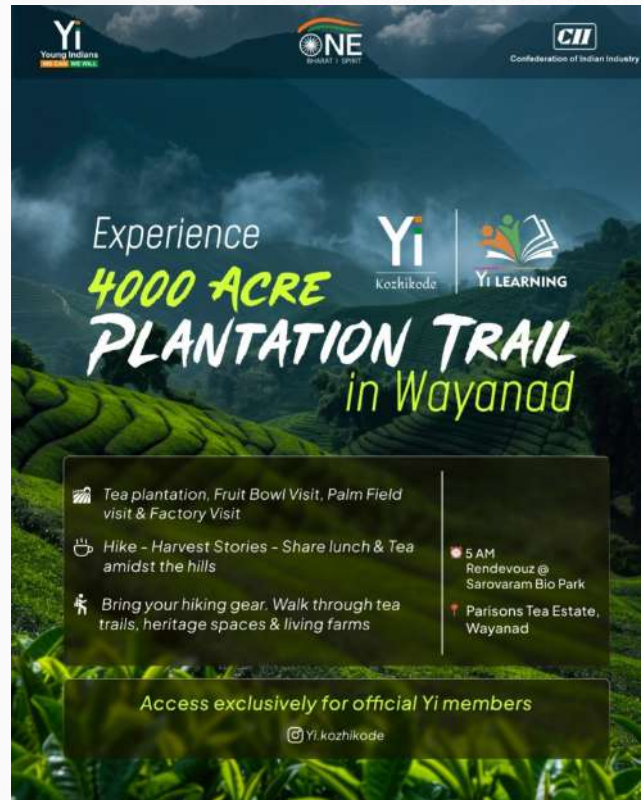
Yi Kozhikode Inspires Future Leaders Through YUVA Orientation

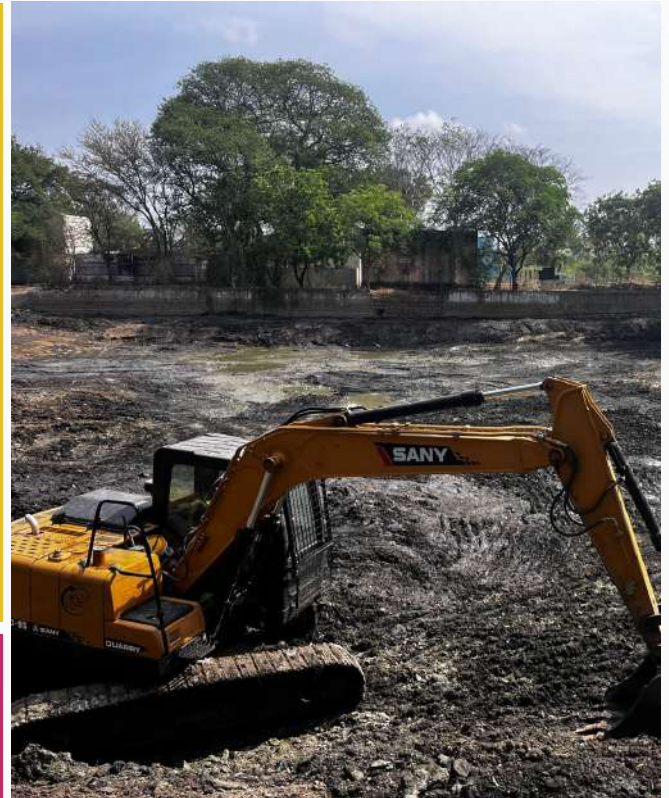

As part of its Climate Change initiatives, Yi Madurai undertook the restoration of Chokkalalingam Oorani, a traditional 1-acre water body, to promote sustainable water management and environmental conservation. With a storage capacity of approximately 5 lakh litres, the rejuvenated oorani is expected to enhance groundwater recharge while also supporting fish farming and local livelihoods. The initiative reflects Yi Madurai's commitment to climate resilience, water conservation, and creating long-term environmental impact for the community.



Yi Hubballi Drives Large-Scale Ecological Restoration

Yi Trivandrum's Climate Change Team successfully led the revival and reorganisation of the century-old Sri Chithira Thirunal Library, one of Kerala's historic knowledge repositories. The initiative is expected to deliver over **500 therapy sessions per month and 6,000+ sessions annually**, significantly enhancing access to developmental support and improving outcomes for children with autism and their families.

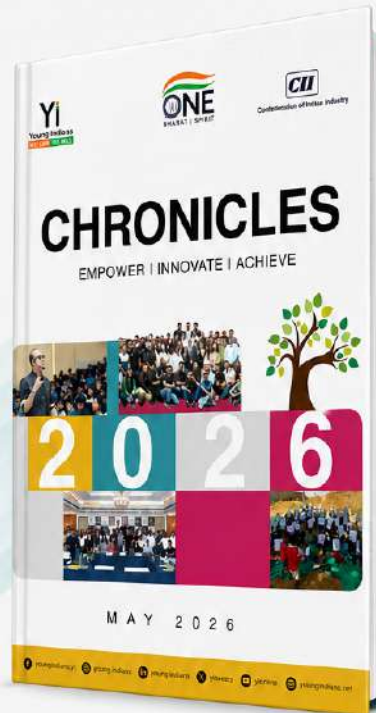


