Catalysing Climate Action: Yi National Climate Change Summit 2026

The Yi National Climate Change Summit 2026, held from 4–6 June in Auroville, brought together 108 Yi delegates, representatives from CII and IWN, and nearly 400 Yuva students for an immersive exploration of sustainable living and climate leadership. Designed as a living laboratory for sustainability, the summit blended thought leadership with experiential learning, encouraging participants to engage in climate action through workshops, nature immersion activities, field visits, and community experiences.

The summit featured inspiring sessions by distinguished speakers, including Dr. Jayanti S. Ravi, Secretary, Auroville Foundation; Prasiddhi Singh, UNICEF India Youth Advocate; and Ravichandran Purushothaman, Chairman, CII Southern Region, and President, Danfoss India. Discussions focused on climate resilience, sustainable entrepreneurship, and translating global challenges into local action.

With zero single-use plastic, fabric-based branding, carbon footprint tracking, eco-conscious accommodation, and innovative waste management practices, the summit established a new benchmark for environmentally responsible events, reaffirming Yi's commitment to leading climate action through purpose, participation, and impact.



VERTICAL UPDATES

Yi Lucknow | Reviving the Gomti

Yi Lucknow organized a clean-up drive at Kudiya Ghat along the banks of the Gomti River, engaging volunteers in waste removal and the clearing of water hyacinth.

The initiative promoted environmental stewardship and community participation while contributing to the restoration of the riverfront's ecological health and natural beauty.



- Yi Guwahati, under the Rural Initiative & Climate Change vertical, successfully conducted its 2nd Plantation Drive 2026 at Nongthymmai Village, promoting environmental sustainability and community participation.
- The drive created a significant impact with the plantation of 2,500 saplings, including 870 Banana plants, 760 Black Pepper plants, and 870 Jujube plants.
- Beyond environmental restoration, the initiative directly supported 26 beneficiary families by creating sustainable livelihood opportunities through fruit-bearing plantations for the years ahead.

Yi Guwahati | Growing Green Futures

Yi Guwahati conducted its second Plantation Drive of 2026 at Nongthymmai Village, planting 2,500 fruit-bearing saplings, including banana, black pepper, and jujube varieties.

The initiative directly benefited 26 families, strengthening livelihoods while promoting environmental sustainability and community development.

Through this impactful initiative, Yi Nashik reinforced its commitment to fostering wellness, discipline, and leadership among young minds.



II4E Convening Advances Inclusive Early Years and Disability Inclusion Agenda

The II4E Multi-Stakeholder Convening on Inclusive Early Years and Disability Inclusion, held on 9 June 2026 in New Delhi, brought together leaders from government, business, healthcare, academia, philanthropy, and civil society to advance the agenda of inclusive child development. Discussions emphasized that inclusive early years are fundamental to building India's future human capital and realizing the vision of Viksit Bharat.

The convening featured insightful addresses by Dr. Nande Putta, UNICEF India; Dr. Neelam Mohan, Indian Academy of Pediatrics; Dr. Pramod Gaddam, Divi's Foundation; Mr. Prateek Agarwal, Yi Health; and Dr. Shobhna Gupta, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. As part of the Yi Raipur Rural Mela held on 10 June 2026 at Government School, Village Tendua, Yi Raipur inaugurated two impactful community initiatives aimed at enhancing rural well-being. A dedicated **Kabaddi Ground Development Initiative** was launched with professional matting, creating lasting sports infrastructure to nurture rural talent, encourage fitness, teamwork, and provide aspiring athletes with opportunities to pursue competitive sports.

Simultaneously, under Project Roshni, more than **100 LED bulbs and table lamps** were distributed to rural households, enabling children to study after dark, improving household safety and productivity, and promoting better living conditions. 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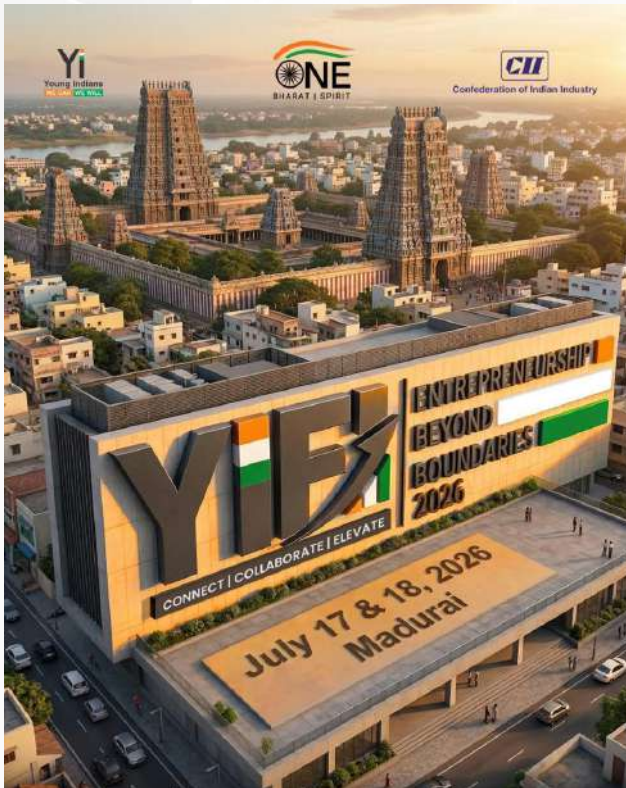

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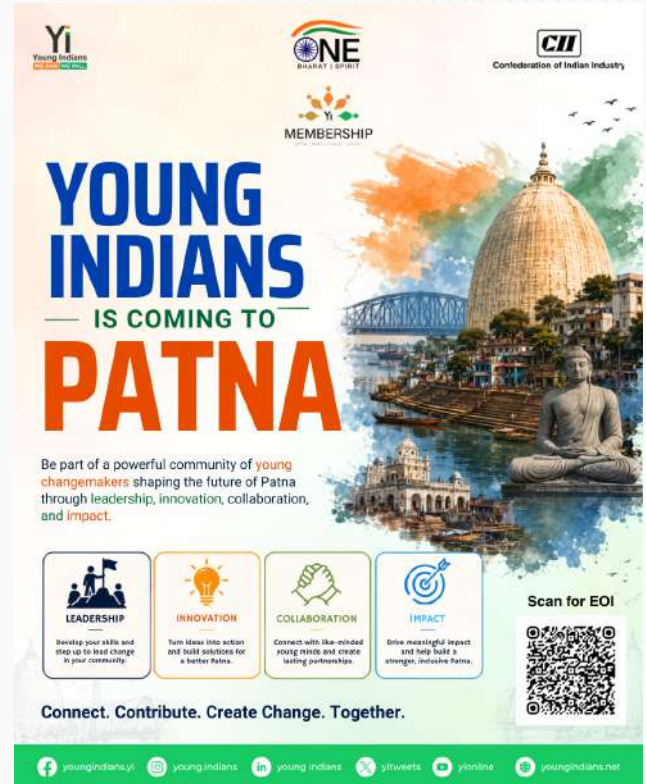
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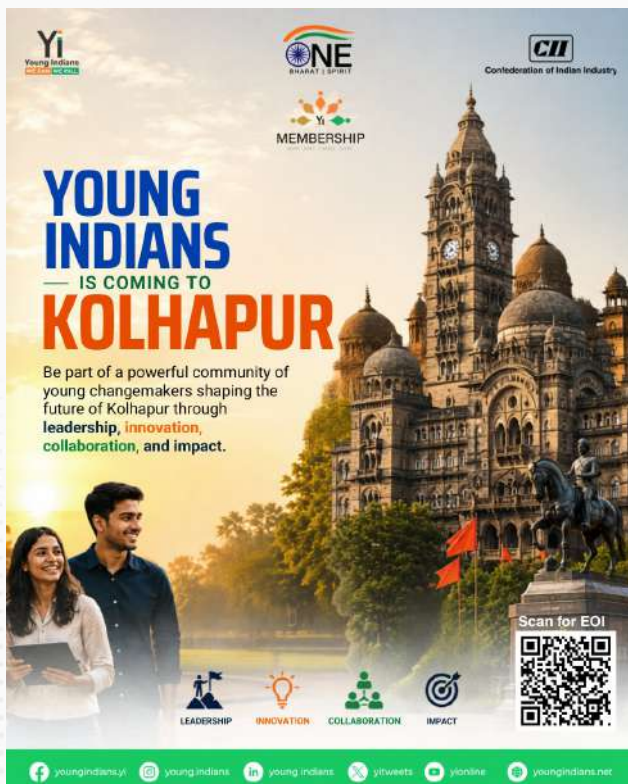
